France - Australia short program funding (Summer/Winter Schools)

The Embassy of France in Australia supports the implementation of short programs through summer or winter school formats co-organised by French and Australian higher education establishments, with an aim to unite students from the two countries through a common subject of interest.

The selected project will benefit from financial support from the Embassy of 4000€.

The aim of the program is to support innovative French-Australian university cooperation initiatives, stimulate student mobility and contribute to the construction of long-term international relations. The projects funded can be in **any field**, past examples have ranged from energy storage material research to language and cultural renewal in the Pacific.

Criteria:

The short program will be **maximum 4 weeks**, allowing students from France to visit Australia, or Australian students to visit France. It can be at **any level** (Undergrad, Honours, Masters, PhD), and for any number of students and teachers, with the understanding that the funding will not increase for a larger cohort size.

The project will be equally conceived or implemented by both the French and Australian higher education institution (including TAFEs, specialised schools, and other certified tertiary education institutions)

The exchange will take place between January and December of the year of application.

Documents needed:

- 1. Application form found <u>here</u>.
- 2. Support letter, signed by both parties.
- Rough budget of the program justifying expenses of the program and how the 4000€ will be spent.

Applications open on January 1st and close on the 30th of June.

Universities can apply at any point throughout the beginning of the year, a decision will be sent within 3 weeks.
